Two Days Human Rights Education Training Program



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'Dignity March' reaches Hyderabad on 5th Jan, 2019

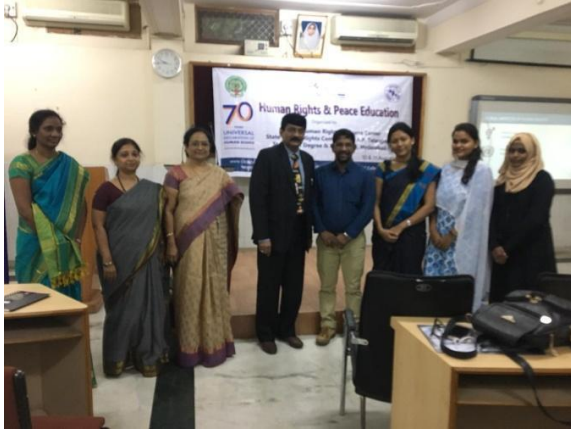

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Make a Wish- December 30, 2018

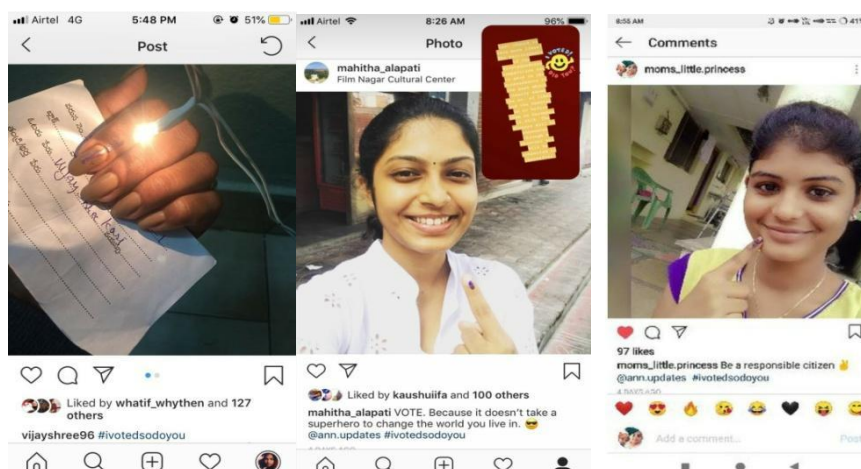

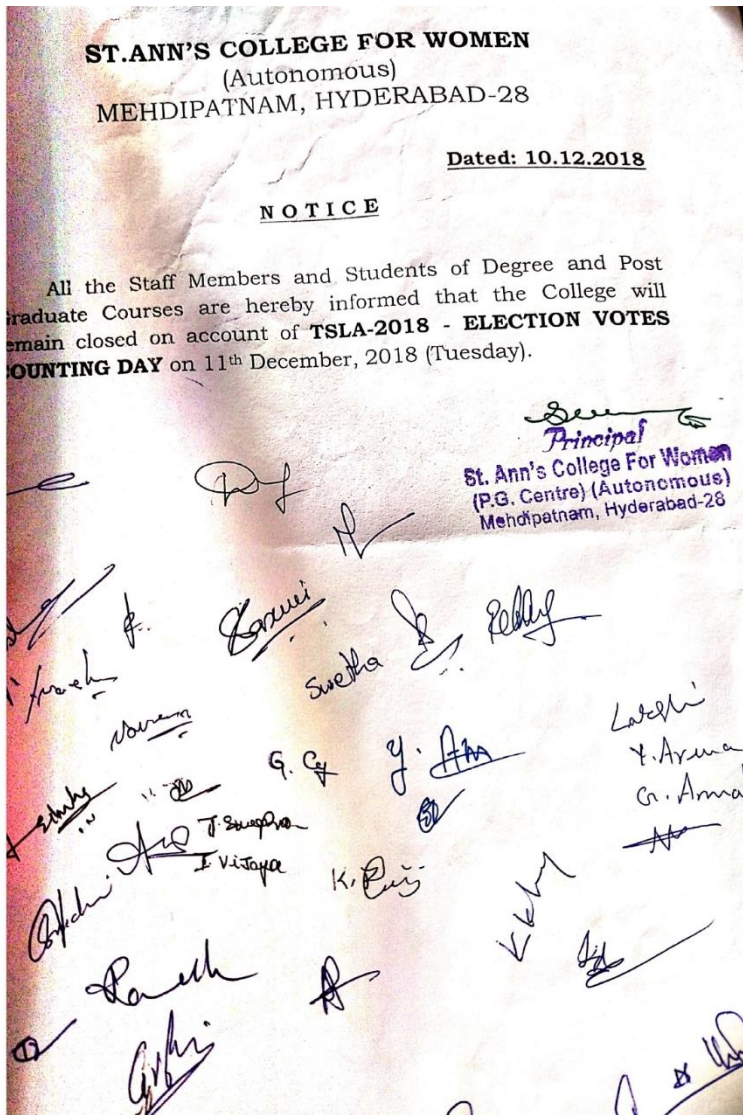

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Guest Lecture on “Challenges to Indian Democracy - role of media” on 30th July, 2018

A Guest lecture was delivered on challenges to Indian Democracy - role of media. The speakers discussed the challenges to Indian democracy, specifically the role of media in shaping it.

The speaker Prof. Y. Prabhajan Yadav, Telangana University, Nizamabad highlighted that one of the primary challenges to the Indian media is the growing influence of political parties and corporate entities. Politicians and business leaders have acquired control of several media organizations, which has led to an erosion of editorial independence. It is said that the media is no longer free to report on stories that could be critical of these entities, leading to a decline in the quality of journalism and the quality of democratic debate.

Sir, says that the proliferation of social media has enabled the spread of false information, which can have a detrimental impact on the democratic process. In India, social media platforms like WhatsApp and Facebook have been used to spread rumors and propaganda, which has fueled communal tensions and contributed to a decline in trust in the media.

Furthermore, the media's role in promoting diversity and inclusivity has come under question. Indian society is diverse and pluralistic, and the media has a responsibility to ensure that all voices are heard. However, the media has been criticized for its lack of representation of marginalized communities, which has led to a one-sided representation of society.

He concluded by saying that, the challenges facing Indian democracy are significant, and the media has an essential role to play in addressing them. The media must remain independent, free, and impartial to report on issues that are critical to democratic debate. It must also promote diversity and inclusivity to ensure that all voices are heard, and the democratic process is strengthened

Department of MBA A workshop on “Cybercrime Protection and Awareness” by Sri. B Mohan Rao, Advocate, for the second year students on 21st August, 2019 wasorganised by the Department.

Objective: To spread awareness about the cyber crimes and their safety measures.

Cyber crime is a dangerous crime involving computers or digital devices, in which a computer can be either a target of the crime, a tool of the crime or contain evidence of the crime. Cyber crime basically defined as any criminal activity that occurs over the Internet. There are many examples such as fraud, malware such as viruses, identity theft and cyber stalking. In present environment, since most information processing depends on the use of information technology, the control, prevention and investigation of cyber activities is vital.

Today, criminals that indulge in cyber crimes are not motivated by ego or expertise. Instead, they want to use their knowledge to gain profits promptly. They are using their capability to snip, deceive and exploit people as they find it easy to generate money without having to do an honest work. Cyber crimes have become major threat today.

There are 3 kind of people who succumb to crime: **Adolescence, Women, Senior citizen.**

Cyber crimes are broadly categorized into many groups such as:

ATM Frauds:

Storage of PIN: People save common possibility of PIN combinations or save in in phone notes or write it on Debit/credit cards which is easy to predict and hack.

Precaution: Use strong PIN, Save only first two digits in case its tough to remember the PIN. Always link mobile number to bank account to receive transaction details.

Skimmer: A skimmer is a card reader that can be disguised to look like part of an ATM. The skimmer attachment collects card numbers and PIN codes, which are then replicated into counterfeit cards.

Precaution: Don't use open ended and isolated ATM's.

Cloning of Cards: Copying information at a credit card terminal using an electronic device or software, then transferring the information from the stolen card to a new card or to rewrite an existing card with the information.

Precaution: Always be attentive while you are swiping the card at public places like Petrol pump, malls etc.

Credit card Frauds: Credit card fraud involves Credit card Fraud, Forgery, Theft. Keep Your Credit Cards Safe, Shred Anything with Your Credit Card Number on It, Don't Sign Blank Credit Card Receipts, Avoid Giving out Your Credit Card Information, Be Safe with Your Credit Card Online, Report Lost or Stolen Credit Cards Immediately, Review Your Billing Statements Each Month, Make Strong Passwords and Keep Them Safe.

Mobile Frauds: Using means of mobile in wrong way. To avoid mobile frauds one should make sure they don't save any personal pictures and videos in the phone. Avoid keeping self pictures as Display pictures. Be careful with IMEI numbers or software while you give your phone for repair. Always get it repaired in front of you. Do not use public WiFi's, Bluetooth with strangers. Wear appropriate dresses while in public areas to not be a victim of Mobile stalking. Avoid buying SIM at umbrella stalls.

Email Frauds: If you think an email might be fraudulent, delete it - don't open it, don't reply to it and don't click on any attachments. Beware of emails that are not personalized. Many phishing emails will start with 'Dear Sir/Madam', because the spammers are sending them out to millions of people. Authentic messages, such as those from your bank, will most often address you by name. Don't use a link within an email to connect to a site unless you're absolutely certain who it's from. These links can lead to phishing websites which look very similar to the real thing. It's better to open a new window and type the URL in directly. Similarly, never enter your data in a log in box that is embedded in an email.

Social Media Cases: A lot of people use social media sites such as Facebook, LinkedIn, Twitter, Google+, and Instagram, to stay in touch with family and friends, meet new people, and interact with businesses like their bank. However, identity thieves can use social media sites in hopes of learning enough information about individuals to be able to figure out passwords, access financial accounts, or commit identity theft.

Precautions: If you have social media apps on your phone, be sure to password protect your device. Be selective with friend requests. If you don't know the person, don't accept their request. It could be a fake account. Be careful about what you

share. Don't reveal sensitive personal information like home address, financial information, phone number. The more you post the easier it is to have your identity stolen. Protect your computer by installing antivirus software to safeguard. Also ensure that your browser, operating system, and software are kept up to date. Remember to log off when you're done.

Government also plays a major role and efforts in women's safety. "HAWK EYE", is an application, A Major area of concern is woman's safety during travel, especially for working women. This Feature helps in ensuring woman's safety while on travel. Whenever a woman board any type of conveyance viz., Taxi, Cab, Auto, Bus, train or any other vehicle, just click the photograph or video of vehicle before boarding, note down vehicle no., place of boarding and send it online to police and they will keep a track of it.

This workshop has helped us learn how to safe guard and secure one's identity. Practice safe strategies to protect oneself.

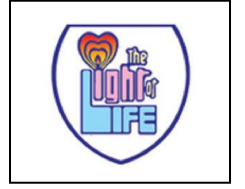

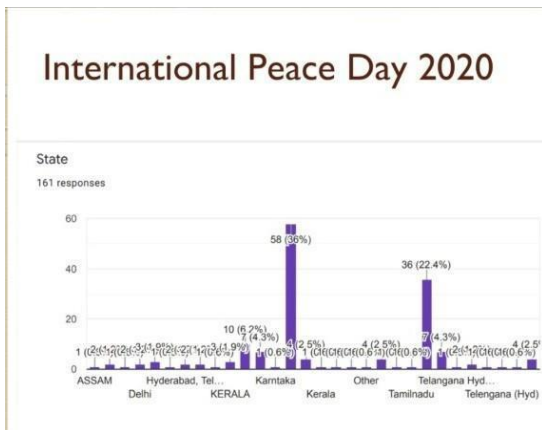
Dr. Sandeep Pandey, Social Activist, Lucknow has talked about peace and conflict resolution.

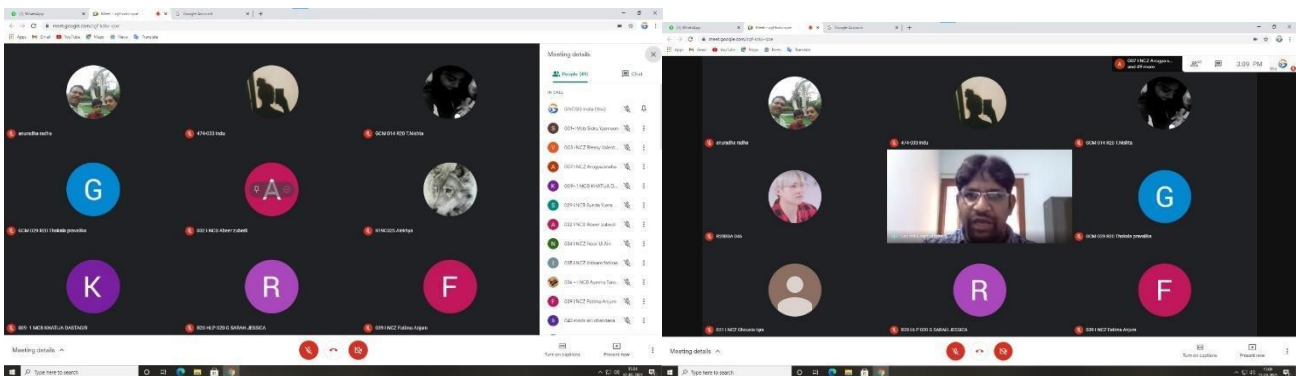

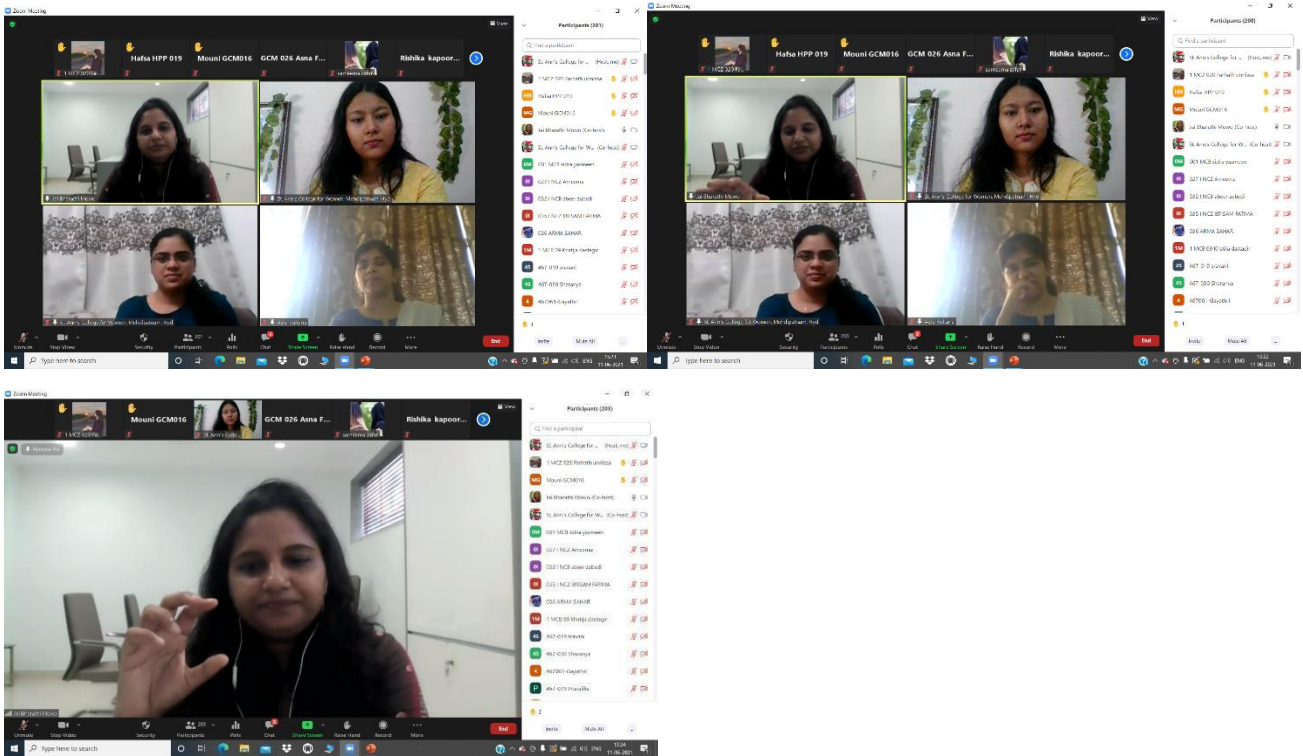

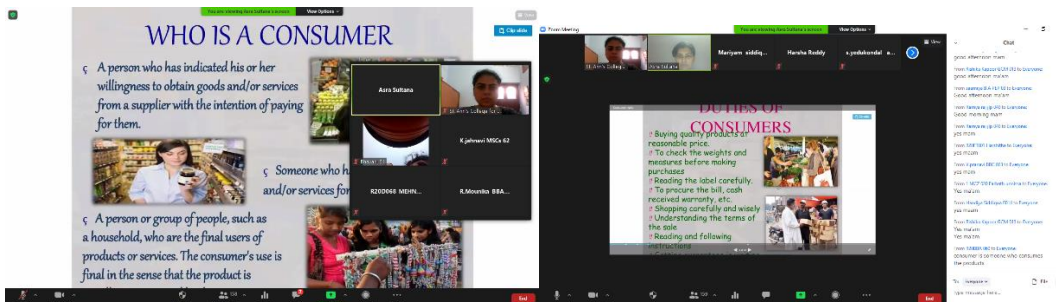
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satisfaction of work and importance of social work. She also appreciated the students for choosing Ngo Management course.

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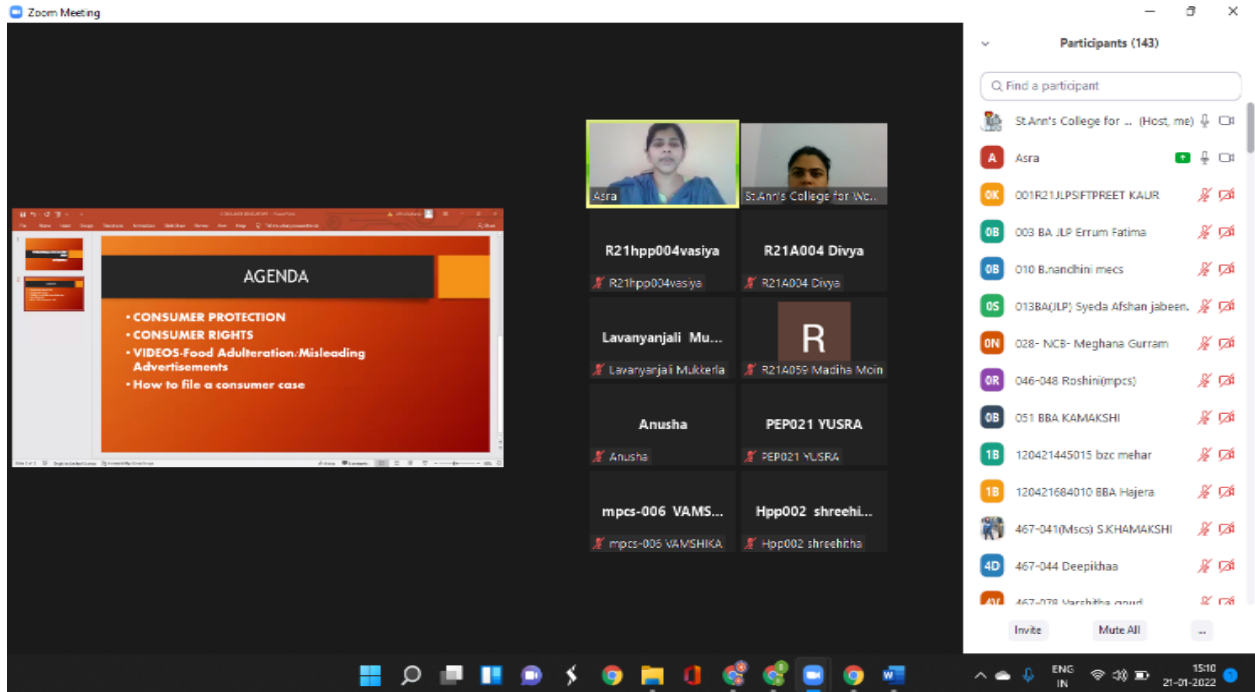
Online Session on Moral Values at St. Albert School, Kishnabagh on 21st Jan, 2022 organised by Centre for Women's Studies.

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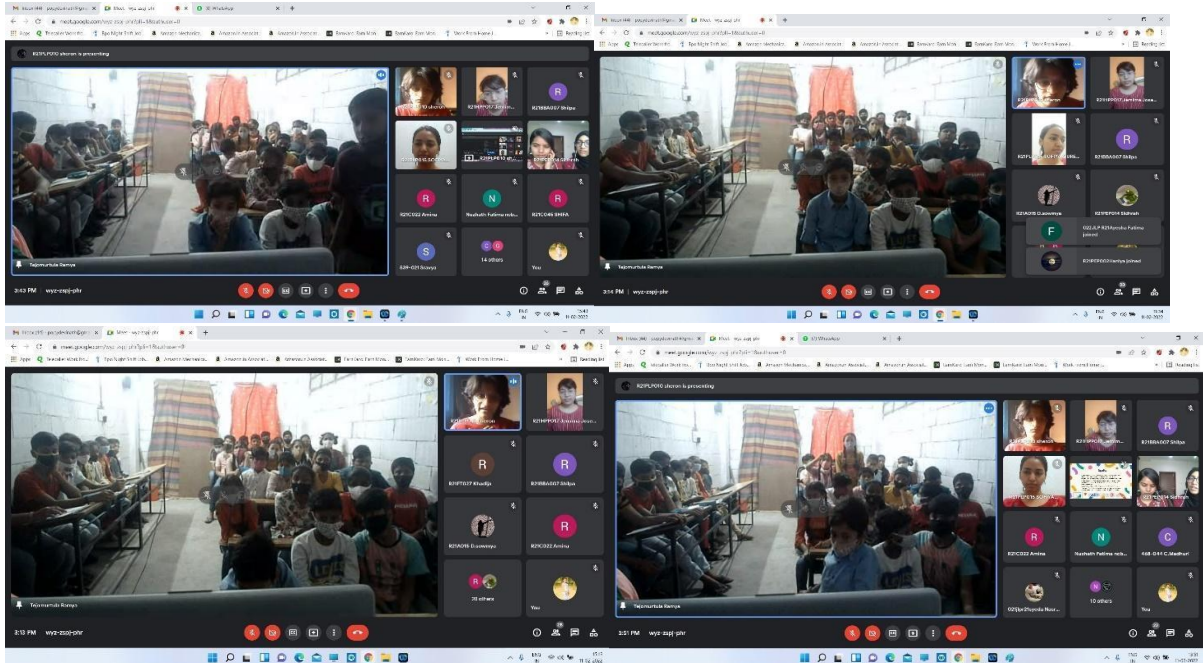

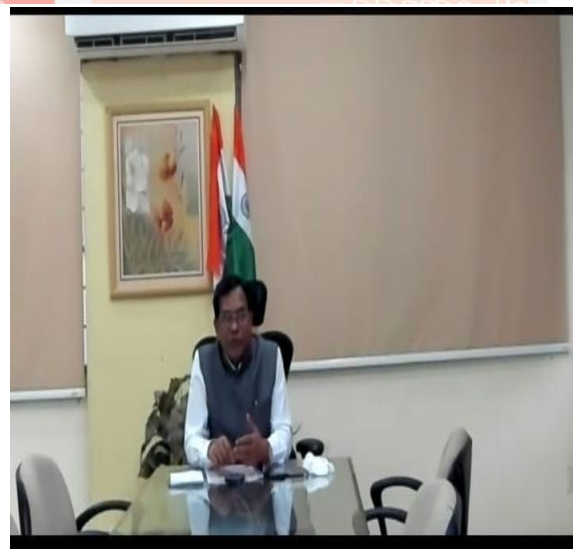
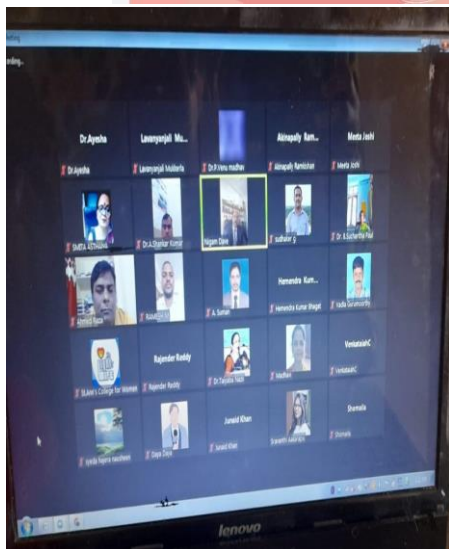

Drug Abuse Awareness Campaign- 24-02-2022

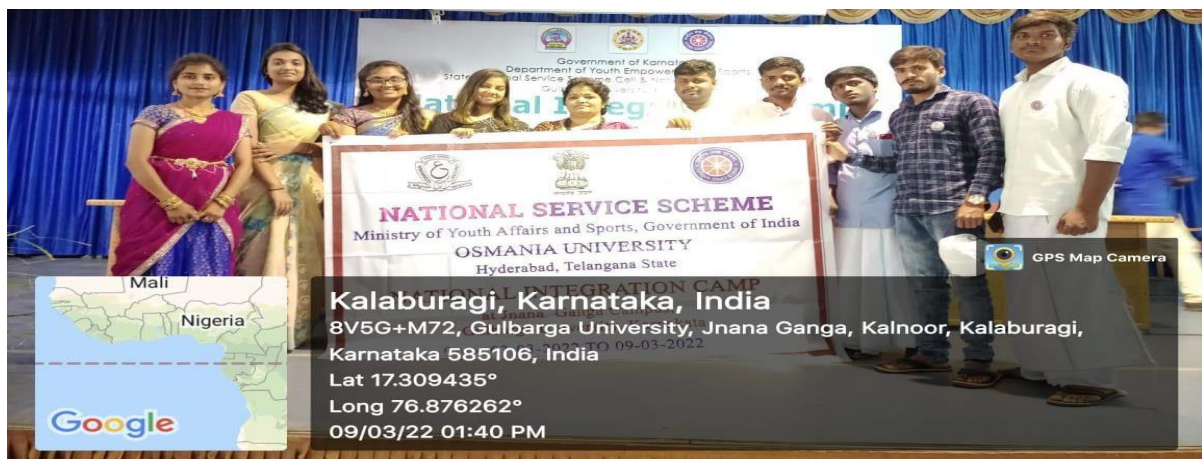

Protection of IPR allows the innovator, brand owner, patent holder and copyright holder to benefit from his/her work, labor and investment, which does not mean monopoly of the intellect. Such rights are set out in the international declaration of Human Rights, which provides for the right to benefit from the protection of the moral and physical interests resulting from the right holder's work; literal or artistic product.

To give a detailed practical applicability, numerous examples related to advertisements, paper presentations, and citations were quoted which had created

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enthusiasm in the students. The session concluded with the precautionary measures to be taken under various segments of Intellectual Property Rights. The session was quite interesting and knowledge gained to students.
