Mrs. Mahitha Davala, Dean Student Affairs, has students general conduct, talked about SQAC.


Dr. Smita Asthana, Dean Academics, has explained about the college rules and ethics.



Online Orientation Programme for the faculty members on 7/08/2020



Student Quality Assurance Cell (SQAC) Orientation


