In this regard NSS volunteers of the college has been actively creating awareness on water conservation by making posters and discussing it with their peers. This activity has been carried on since 2020.






Activities 2021-22

Activities 2022-23


Centre for Women's Studies organised a guest lecture on Water Conservation on 8th December, 2022


