



Brief Report:

Preliminary Round

- 1. There will be 2 teams consisting of 3 members each. In this round one team will be in proposition and the other in opposition of the topic given. 2. Both the teams will have 20 minutes in total. The total time of debating is structured into 3 parts:
 - Part 1: Each team will be allotted a total time of 6 minutes to put forth their proposition and opposition on the topic, wherein, each member of the teams will be allotted 2 minutes to speak.
 - Part 2: A total time of 4 minutes is allotted to the Rebuttal Round, wherein, both teams are allotted 2 minutes each.





- Part 3: Questions Round which has been allotted a total time of 4 minutes, wherein, both teams are allotted 2 minutes each.
- 3. A detailed layout of procedure for the preliminary round is explained below. Here we assume that in the debate there are two teams: Team A and Team B, Team A represents the Proposition and Team B represents the Opposition.
 - In Part 1, the Opening Speaker from Team A will speak for duration of 2 minutes followed by the Opening Speaker of Team B, who will also speak for duration of 2 minutes.
 - The second speaker of Team A will address the floor next and will speak for duration of 2 minutes, followed by the second speaker of Team B, who will also be allotted 2 minutes to speak.
 - The Closing Speaker of Team A will now address the floor followed by the Closing Speaker of Team B. Both Speakers are allotted a time of 2 minutes each.
 - We then move to Part 2, the Rebuttal Round where each team is allotted a time limit of 2 minutes to rebuttal the points put forward by the other team.
 - The debate session ends with Part 3 i.e.; Questions Round wherein each team is allotted a time limit of 2 minutes to pose questions to the other team.
 - 4. The topic of your preliminary round is already stated in the mail.
- 5. The further details of rules of procedure of the semi- final and final round will be sent to you depending on your performance in the preliminary round.
 - 6. Kindly make sure you have proper internet connection. 7. The decisions taken by the Chair of the debate session are final.


