7. To organise outreach activities to help and support differently abled children by adopting schools meant for them.

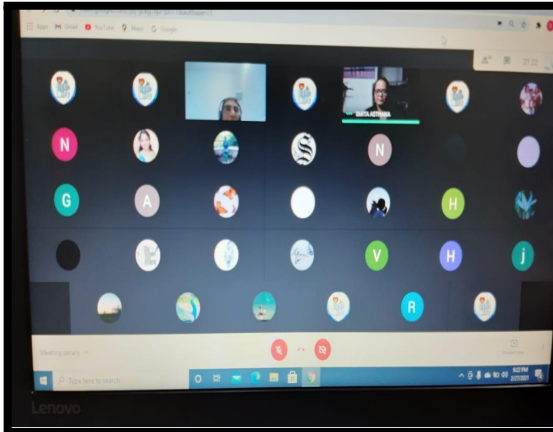
Report of activities;
