This August, the cell has organised a contest on 'Consumer Conflict Resolution on 28th August 2021.







Date:14-03-2022


Brief Report:


Event:Lunch Theatre

Event: Logo designing and tagline contest







The Equinox club organised an event "WAR OF WORDS" for the students of BBA I year on 4 December 2021.


TOPIC: Educational Institutions should aim at creating more Entrepreneurs than Managers.






On the occasion of World Earth Day, SQAC in collaboration with Dharini Eco-Club organized a week worth of educational and fun events for the students and faculty members.






Event: Essay writing competition


Event: Mosquito Awareness Programme - "Beat the Blood Suckers"






