  - Elocution on Artificial Intelligence


Prizes were given for winning individuals and teams in the form of appreciation certificates.

The responses from the participants for this event were phenomenal as students from within the college and from outside the college had participated in it.












Event 24 : **Celebrate the world of flavours**" Date: 25-09-2022 Brief Report:
