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Academic Council in its last meeting conducted on 3rd July 2021 for which all the members expressed their consent and congratulated the team.

- Dr. Smita presented the new, revised and renamed courses/programs like Environmental studies, Gender Sensitization, Computer skills as AECC, Digital marketing, Entrepreneurship and Startup management as CCA, Design thinking as skill, Herbal Medicines and Beauty Care as SOC, certificate course in Health and Nutrition Informatics, and revised and renamed B Com (Business Process Management) in collaboration with TCS in place of B Com (International Accounting and Finance)
- She outlined various papers to be taught in B.Com. (Business process management) on a query by Prof. Sreeramulu. He suggested that institution should check with OU/UGC guidelines from time to time with respect to starting new programs.
- Dr.Sreeramulu also suggested about quality MOUs rather than their numbers.
- Dr.Radhai presented Almanac, Examination reforms mentioning the existing policies and their modifications viz., switching over to 70:30 (external: internal marks) both for UG and PG ,minimum passing as 40 percent both in ESE and aggregate, the modified grade structure in accordance with UGC frame work, overall promotional policy.
