SAIC helps to support the system for budding entrepreneurs and start-ups. SAIC undertake the following functions:

## • Infra-Structure Facilities

SAIC room equipped with working face, furniture, ICT and printer. A physical infrastructure room shall be provided to facilitate periodic meetings, networking and mentoring of budding entrepreneurs.

## • Start-up Activities

SAIC organizes entrepreneur-focused seminars, webinars, ideathon presentations, and hackathons, among other things, as part of the Institution Innovation Council's (IIC) calendar and self-driven activities to guide and motivate young minds and aspiring entrepreneurs.

## • Mentoring Support

To generate business ideas and innovation, SAIC frequently organizes business plan competitions, idea presentations, simulations, and brainstorming sessions.
