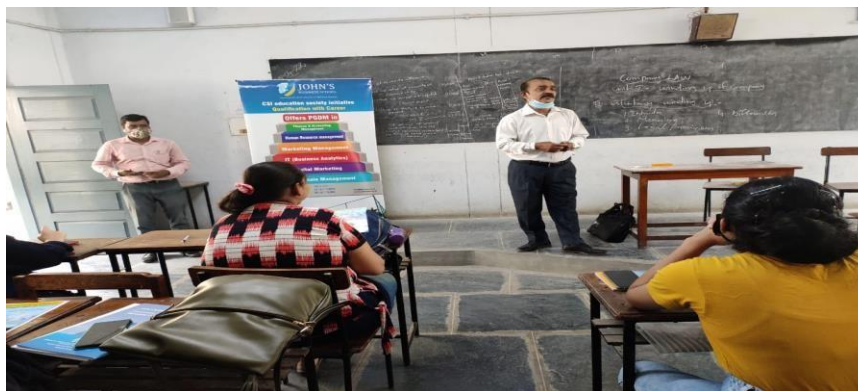

The students cleared their doubts by asking various questions regarding the confusions, they usually face while deciding their career.

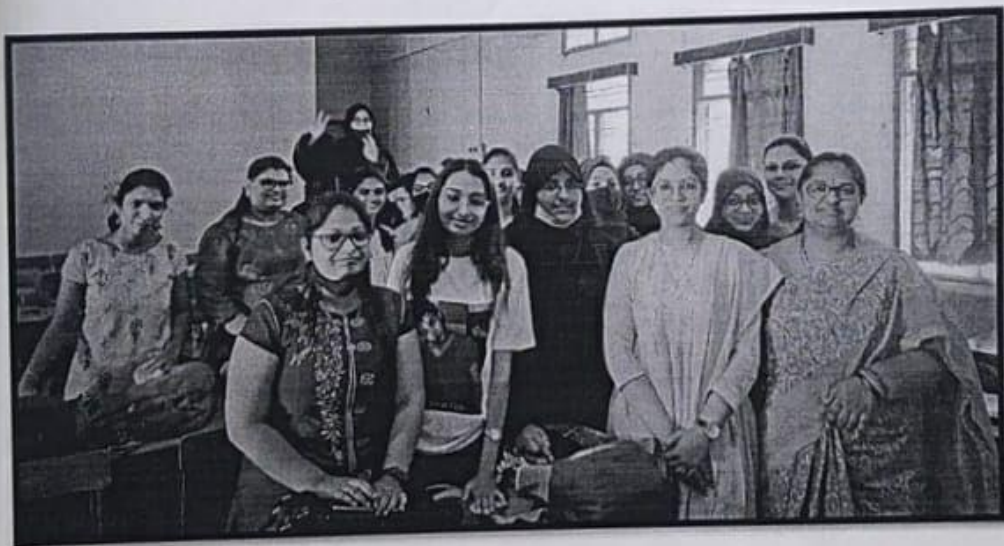

As part of career counseling session for final year students of R19 batch, the Department of Nutrition, St. Ann's College, organized an International Career Counseling Session on 27th April, 2022.



The session was organized on Google Meet platform from 5:00 PM onwards.

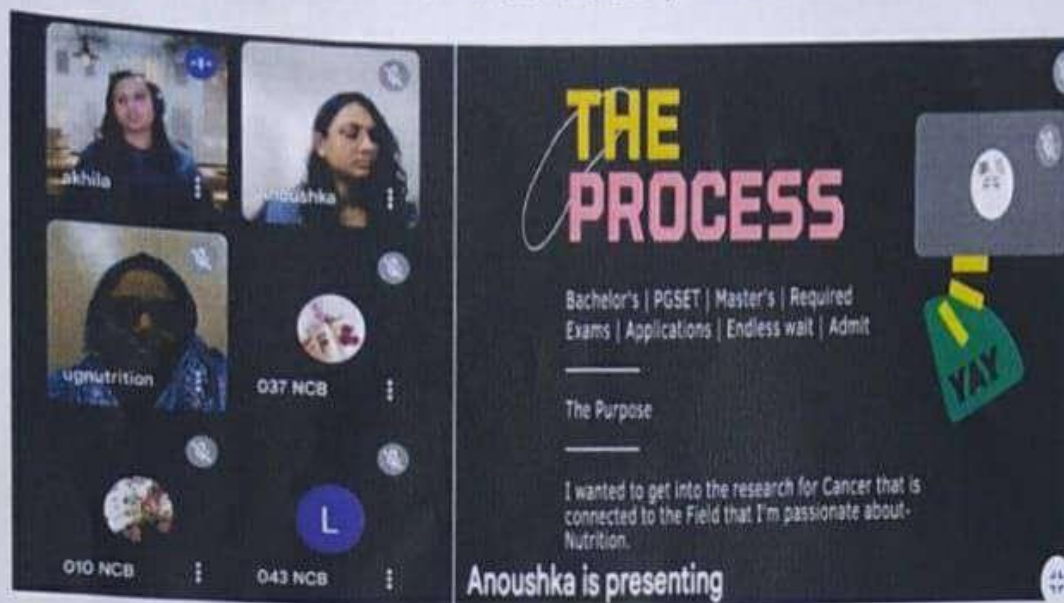
The first speaker was Ms. Akhila Gopishetty from Australia. She introduced herself and talked about her education in India, the additional courses she did, her processing for abroad studies, number of universities she applied in, acceptance rejection, her experience, etc.

Ms Akhila completed her bachelors from St. Ann's College, Hyderabad. She did her masters in Clinical Nutrition from Koti Women's College. Upon doing research on various universities in Australia, she realized the need for 16 years study to be eligible for admission for Masters in Australia. Basing on this, she did an internship in SPSS and also a course on Research and methodology. She then applied in 7 universities of which she got selected in 3 universities and other 4 universities rejected her. At this, she advised the students to be well prepared in advance to accept rejections.

She pursued her double Masters from University of Wollongong, Australia. From her experience, she emphasized that the studies there are very different from here in India. So she asked the students to be well prepared for that. In response to a query, she said that doing Double Masters is necessary especially in Clinical Nutrition field as the eating habits, food preferences of foreigners are very

different. So an intensive study has to be done to be able to understand the health problems they suffer from and the dietary modifications to be done.



The session was continued by Ms Anoushka Darga from Boston, USA. She also completed her bachelors from St. Ann's College. Masters from Koti Women's college. She was passionate in doing research on cancer, so currently she is studying metabolism in 4T1 cells and their response to adipocytes crosstalk. She began by addressing the students on the prerequisite skills and qualities that are required and needs to be worked upon and enhanced.

1. Communication- Students planning to move abroad must inculcate good and effective communication skills. It is important to have connections with professors, students, Ex- students, etc., as it can help get good advises and suggestions in time and navigate through various opportunities and grab the correct one.
2. Identify area of passion - Important aspect is to navigate through various fields and identify the subject of interest like food science, Clinical Nutrition, food technology, etc.
3. Time management- Working according to priorities can help timely completion of work and prevent workloads.

It helps to know if one is able to adapt to the work environment, kind of work etc. It helps make clear decisions in future.

Brief Feedback Analysis Report on Msc Coaching 2020-21

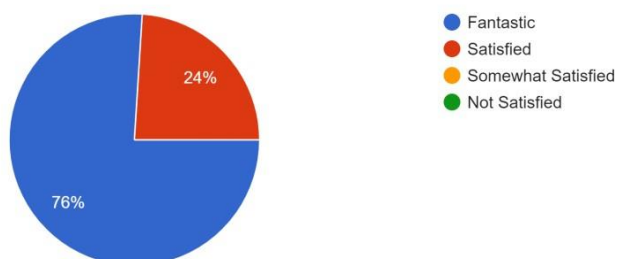

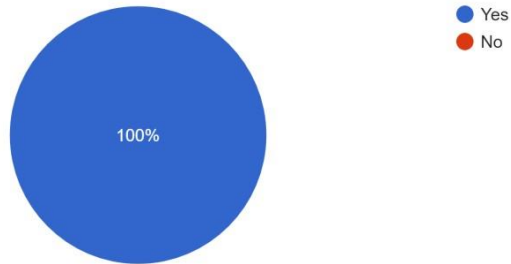


