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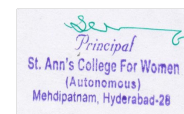


WEBINAR ON UPCOMING CAREER OPPORTUNITIES FOR GRADUATES

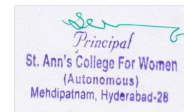
1st February,2023

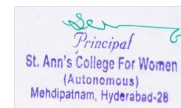
Being a Biologist, she explained how one needs to put in long hours of study with perseverance and patience to meet the set goals.

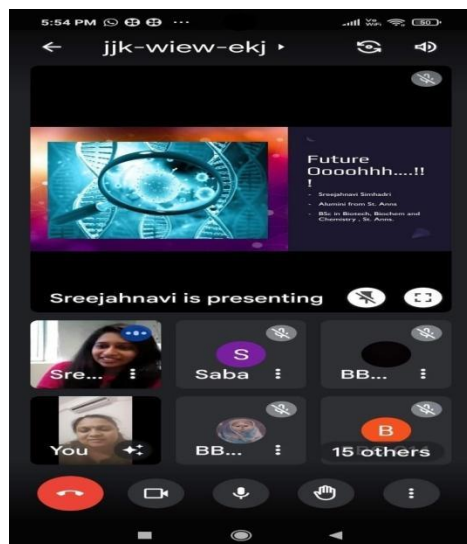

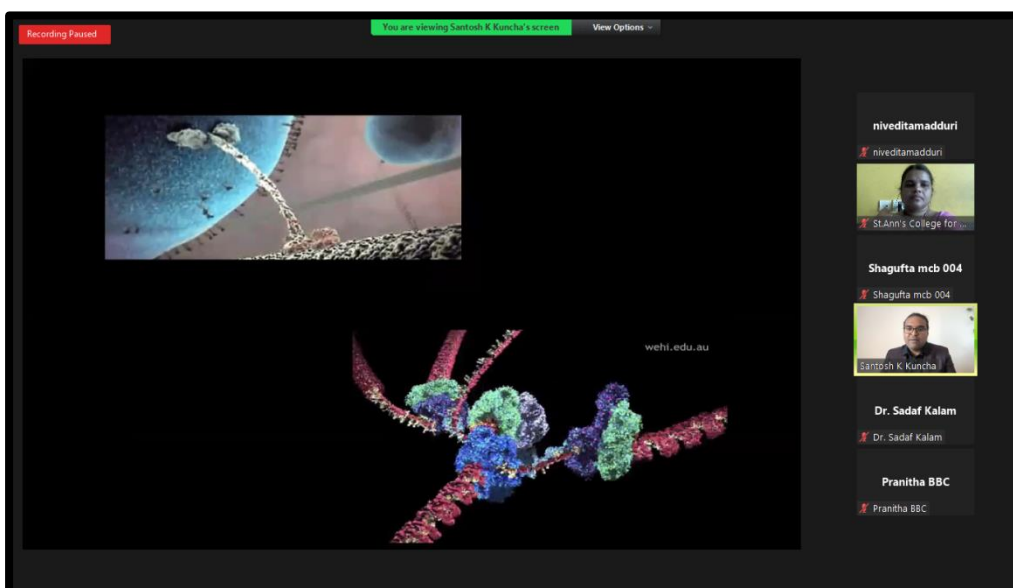
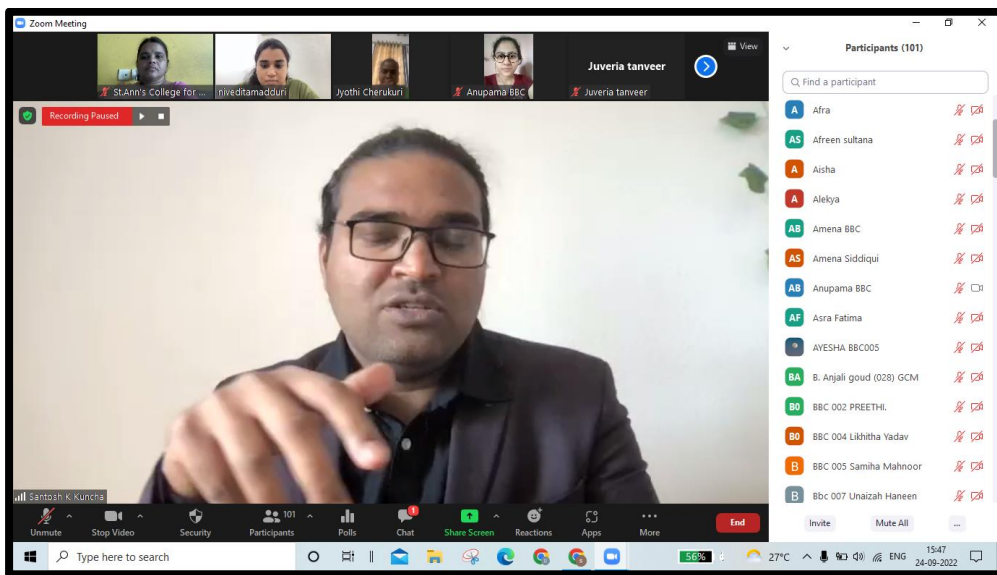

Dr. Indira, the program producer, gave the students information on audience research and the schedule for a community radio station.



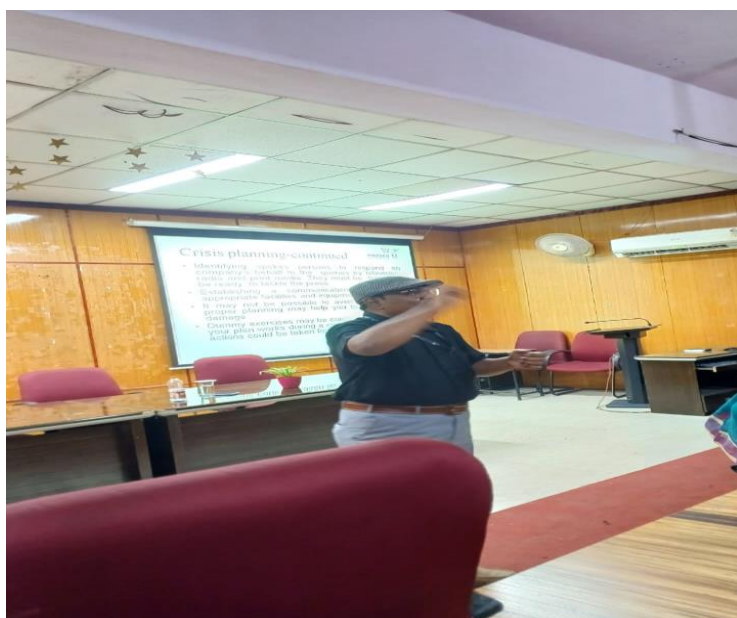
REPORT ON ONE-DAY SEMINAR





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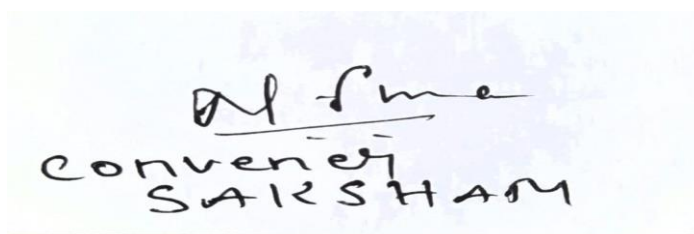
