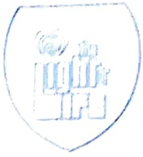

8. Dr Smita proposed the theme for the upcoming year – ‘Scaling Challenges’ followed by institutional plans including proposals for shift/staggered system,



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
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
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plans for online classes and Internal examinations, and work being done towards Extension of Autonomy status.


9. Dr Radhika presented plans of the Autonomy Finance Committee

 - b. Changing pattern of exam (increased marks for short sections) to benefit students



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
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
12. Ms. Kanaka Durga lauded the efforts and activities taken by the college during the pandemic situation.







1. The meeting began with Dr. Sr. Amrutha, Chairperson and Principal, leading the members in prayer. She welcomed the academic council members to the meeting with her opening remarks.
2. Dr. Smita Asthana, Dean, Academics and IQAC coordinator presented the institutional highlights for the year 2019-20, and invited Heads of the Departments to present the syllabus as approved in respective Board of Studies meetings to be followed from 2020-21 onwards till further revision.
3. Dr. Meena Patangey, Dean, Administration and Head, Department of Nutrition, presented the highlights of BOS members, courses, syllabus, credits, evaluation pattern, model paper, panel of examiners, reference books as approved by BOS from the academic year 2020-21 onwards for the departments of English, Second Languages (Arabic, French, Hindi, Sanskrit and Telugu), Social Sciences (Economics, English Literature, History, Political Sciences, Psychology, Public Administration), Biological Sciences (UG) (Botany, Chemistry, Zoology, Applied Nutrition, Biochemistry, Biotechnology, Genetics, Microbiology) and Physical Sciences (UG) (Computer Science, Electronics, Mathematics, Physics, Statistics). 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
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18. Dr. Sr. P. Amrutha read out the resolutions for which members have given their approval.

20. The Academic Council members complimented the college and the faculty for their dedication and efforts. They wished everyone good luck and asked everyone to keep up the good work.




The following resolutions were made:
