



Teaching pedagogy, Software/ICT tools used

A blended mode of teaching learning method is being practiced to make it different from the routine way of classroom teaching and help the learner comprehend the subject knowledge quickly. The pedagogy used in the classroom teaching include direct instruction with an aim of dispersal of knowledge followed by testing/assessing the knowledge acquired, couching the student to facilitate her to comprehend the subject knowledge.
